II Corinthians 2: 10-11 (This is Paul talking to the church of Corinth)

Now when you forgive anything I also forgive. For if indeed I have forgiven anything, I have forgiven that one for your sakes in the presence of Christ. Lest Satan should take advantage of us, for we are not ignorant of his devices. (Self torment is eminent when you don't forgive)

Matthew 6:14-15

For if you forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Comment [1]:

Matthew 6:9-13 The Lords Prayer

Our father in heaven hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come your will be done on earth as it is in heaven give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors and do not lead us into temptation but deliver us from the evil one for Your is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever amen.

Comment [2]:

Did you know that if you don't forgive people it's actually like tormenting yourself? To hold onto an offense, creates bitterness, sickness, depression it's really not worth it. But some people have done such heinous crimes that you don't even know where to start to forgive them. We really need the Holy Spirit's help to empower us to forgive them, right? We need Godly wisdom, like it says in the book of Ephesians...

[By The Grace of God, the paragraph below will change your life, read it daily]

Ephesians 1:17-23

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ the father of glory, may give you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being in enlightened that you may know what is the hope of His calling and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the Saints and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at the right hand in the heavenly places far above all principality and power and might and dominion and every name that is named not only in this age but also in that which is to come and He put all things under His feet and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church which is His body the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

There's hidden treasure in all scripture and the one above opens your heart and mind to Godly wisdom; read it memorize it meditate on it, that's what King David did as recorded in Psalms.

Here's a simple prayer to help you let go of offense and to finally forgive those who've hurt you.

"Father God I come to You and I thank You for all that You have done, for You are great Lord.
